This initiative responds to the NDP III and a Presidential Directive to leverage information technology for improving medical supplies accountability, the quality of healthcare, and continuity of care based on transferable medical records. In this regard, the Ministry of Health has procured computers with support from various partners.

Unfortunately, it has been noticed and documented that several computers have gone missing. Some have been lost by staff, some are damaged beyond repair, among other issues and no action has been taken or put in place to prevent further loss. These computers are vital for our ongoing efforts to digitize patient records and streamline our operations for better efficiency and service delivery. Therefore, given the critical nature of this program, we kindly request your assistance in recovering the lost computers. We are confident that with your help, we can recover the lost computers and continue our digitization initiative within 3 months.

The digitization of health service delivery is part of a wider digitization of Government services. Any efforts to slow or delay decisions made towards fast-tracking these efforts may be considered an act of sabotage. Failure to follow these instructions with urgency, will force the Ministry of Health to escalate the recovery of this equipment to the Health Monitoring Unit and other law enforcement entities, with instructions to also investigate the reasons and circumstances surrounding this issue.
